We are pleased to announce the 2nd Jan Lindhe Symposium on *Clinical Periodontology and Implant Dentistry*, an international conference organized by the Sahlgrenska Academy at Göteborg University in association with the Scandinavian Society of Periodontology. The Symposium will be held in the Conference Center Wallenberg, Göteborg University, Sweden on 18-19 April 2008.
